Q: Can someone explain to me why it is a misnomer to say "fatal" to some disease/condition? Possible Duplicate: When is a disease not a disease? For

example, in plain English I've always assumed that "fatal" is a very dangerous illness, for which there may be treatment/cure, like "treatable". The other way around, "treatable" is usually considered less dangerous than "fatal". But are they just different or one is more dangerous than the other in some cases? A: The term fatal is often misused in medicine, but it doesn't have anything to do with disease severity. You can have a fatal outcome and an un-fatal outcome. If you fall and die, you can be considered as having a fatal outcome, but if you simply break a leg, you can be considered to have an un-fatal outcome. A: It's a bit of an edge case, but it depends on how you define the word "fatal" in a medical context. Basically, anything where death is a permanent condition, but where the outcome is not fatal by medical standards, would be described as fatal. Thus, even without a proven treatment, your outcome will be considered a fatal outcome because it is always fatal. However, if the outcome is going to be fatal in the sense of a "fatal" outcome, but the condition doesn't result in death, it would be "non-fatal" or "treatable".
